CIRCULAR

FOR THE INFORMATION OF STUDENTS

1. The practice of **RAGGING** is a **non bailable punishable offence under IPC** which has taken the shape of extreme harassment, terror, physical and mental torture of fresher's by the students of higher class or so called seniors.
2. All students must know that:
 - a) Any act by a student against any other student amounting to causing, inducing, compelling or forcing student in any way.
 - b) To do any act which detracts from human dignity or violates his person or exposes him to ridicule or to tease him?
 - c) For bearing from doing any lawful act by intimidating, wrongfully restraining, wrongfully confining, or injuring him or using force to him.
 - d) Holding out to him by any threat of such intimidations, restraint, confinement, injury or use of force.
 - e) Physical, mental and sexual abuse of fresh students at the college/university campus or outside by the senior students.
 - f) Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any junior student.
 - g) Indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student.
 - h) Asking the student(s) to do any act or perform something which the student will not do in an ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.
 - i) The following acts within or outside campus shall also amount ragging:
 - I. Introduction in any form by a group seniors or individuals
 - II. Calling seniors as 'Sir, 'Madam or 'Boss,
 - III. To ask to do manual jobs for seniors like getting water, buying items from shops
 - IV. To copy class notes
 - V. To ask answer vulgar questions or force to look at obscene pictures, etc.
 - VI. To force to consume alcohol, smoking or the like
 - VII. To participate into group or individual sexual acts.
3. Any kind of act by any male student against a female student which amounts to **"Assault or criminal force to woman with intent to outrage her modesty"** is an offence punishable under section 354 of Indian Penal Code 1860.

Such acts falling in the above categories shall be punishable with any or more of the following punishments:

1. Outright expulsion from the University.
2. Barring from appearing in placement interviews.
3. Withholding results, scholarships or other benefits.
4. Fine with a public apology.
5. Suspension from the classes/University for a limited period.
6. Suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess.
7. An FIR may be lodged in Police Station.
8. Any other punishment decided by the University management and Anti-Regging Committee.
